

# Health Insurance Options for Immigrant Families

Does my family qualify for financial assistance to get health insurance if we are...

Lawfully present immigrant.  
(Permanent resident less than 5 years, or TPS, VAWA, U Visa, applicants for Asylum, SIJS, F1 visa, and many others)



Refugee, Asylee, Cuban/Haitian Entrant, T visa, Permanent resident for more than 5 years.

## Marketplace

you may qualify for financial assistance if your household income is below:

- \$48,560 (family of 1)
- \$100,400 (family of 4)

## Medicaid

only children and pregnant women may qualify, if meet specific income requirements (see back for more details)

## Marketplace

you may qualify if your household income is between:

- \$12,140 - \$48,560 (family of 1)
- \$25,100 - \$100,400 (family of 4)

## Medicaid

In North Carolina, Medicaid covers limited categories of individuals who are:

- disabled, the caretaker of children under 18 years old, age 65 or older, pregnant, or a child less than 19 years old

AND

- also meet specific income requirements (see back for more details)

Undocumented immigrants or DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrival) may be eligible for Emergency Medicaid and can utilize low costs and free clinics at [medlinkofmecklenburg.org](http://medlinkofmecklenburg.org)
