

Medicaid

only children and pregnant women may qualify, if meet specific income requirements (see back for more details)

Undocumented immigrants or DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrival) may be eligible for Emergency Medicaid and can utilize low costs and free clinics at medlinkofmecklenburg.org



Refugee, Asylee, Cuban/Haitian Entrant, T visa, Permanent resident for more than 5 years.

- \$12,140 \$48,560 (family of 1)
- \$25,100 \$100,400 (family of 4)

Medicaid

In North Carolina, Medicaid covers limited categories of individuals who are:

- disabled, the caretaker of children under 18 years old, age 65 or older, pregnant, or a child less than 19 years old
 AND
- also meet specific income requirements (see back for more details)
